

The following is an analysis of the 5 year trends in National Pollutant Inventory reports from the Commonwealth government

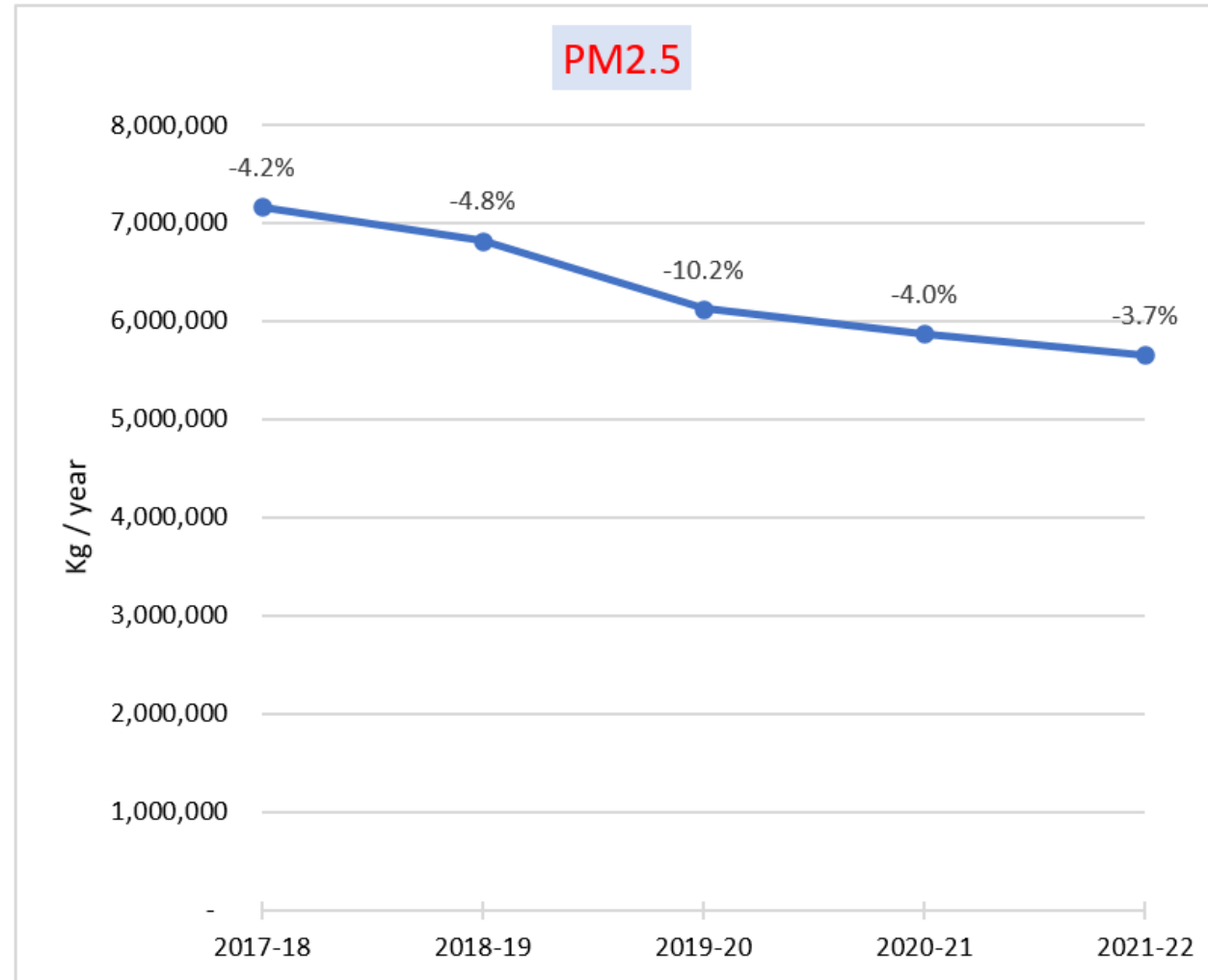
The slides are the aggregated NPI results from coal fired electricity generators across Australia.

Definitions:

- “PM2.5” and “PM10” means “Particulate Matter 2.5 microns or less” and “Particulate Matter 10 microns or less” respectively.
- SO<sub>2</sub> means Sulphur Dioxide emissions
- NO<sub>x</sub> means oxides of Nitrogen emissions

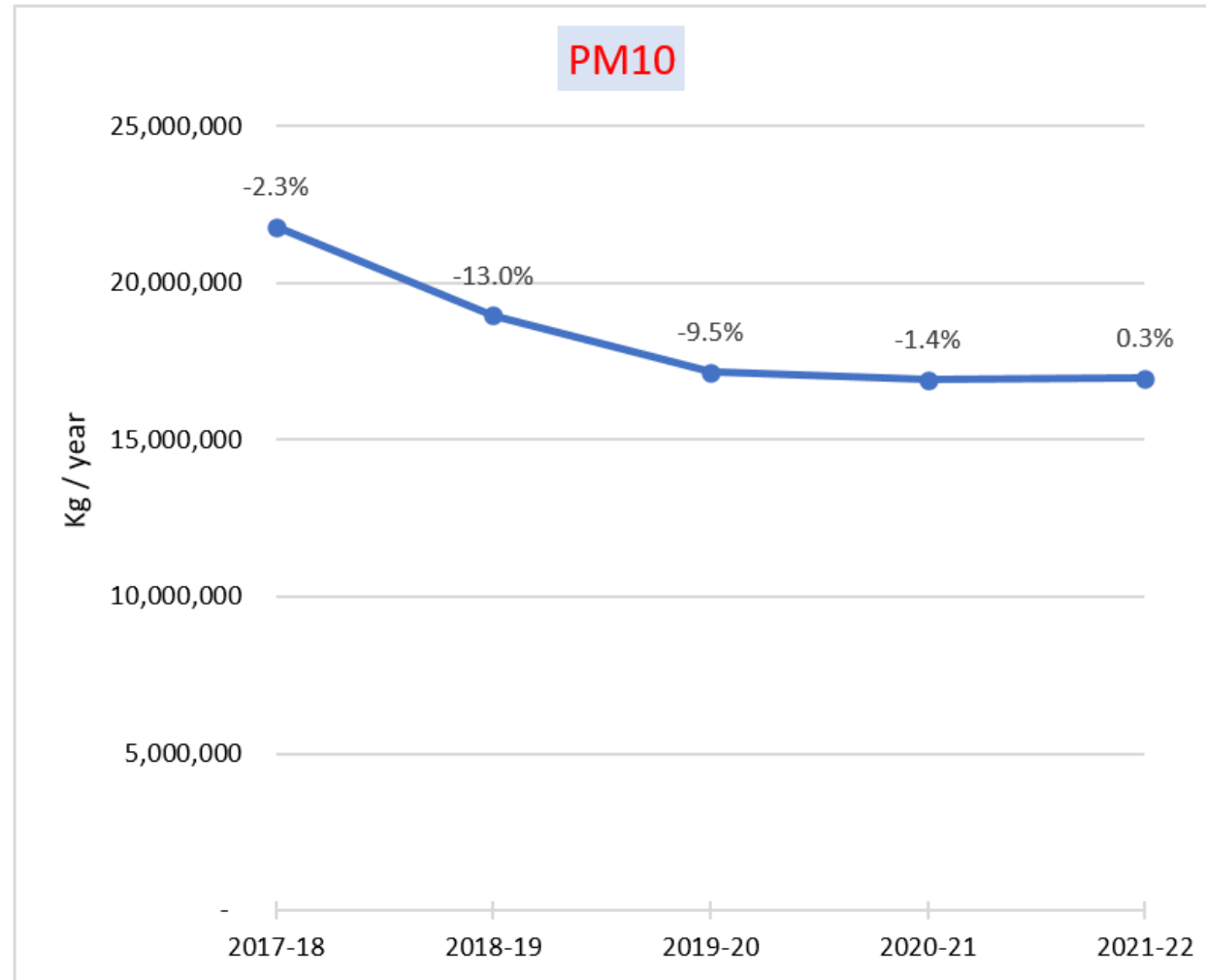

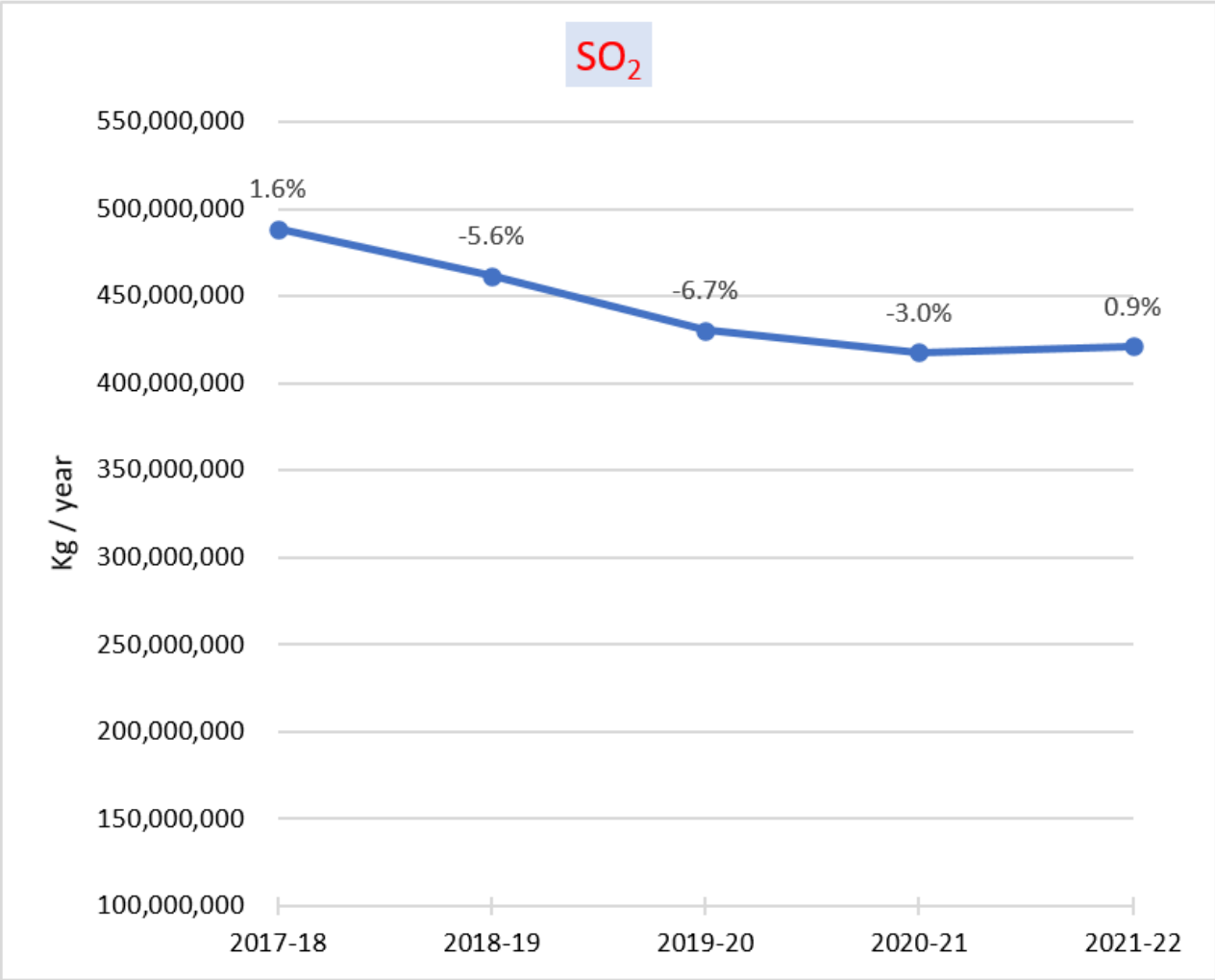

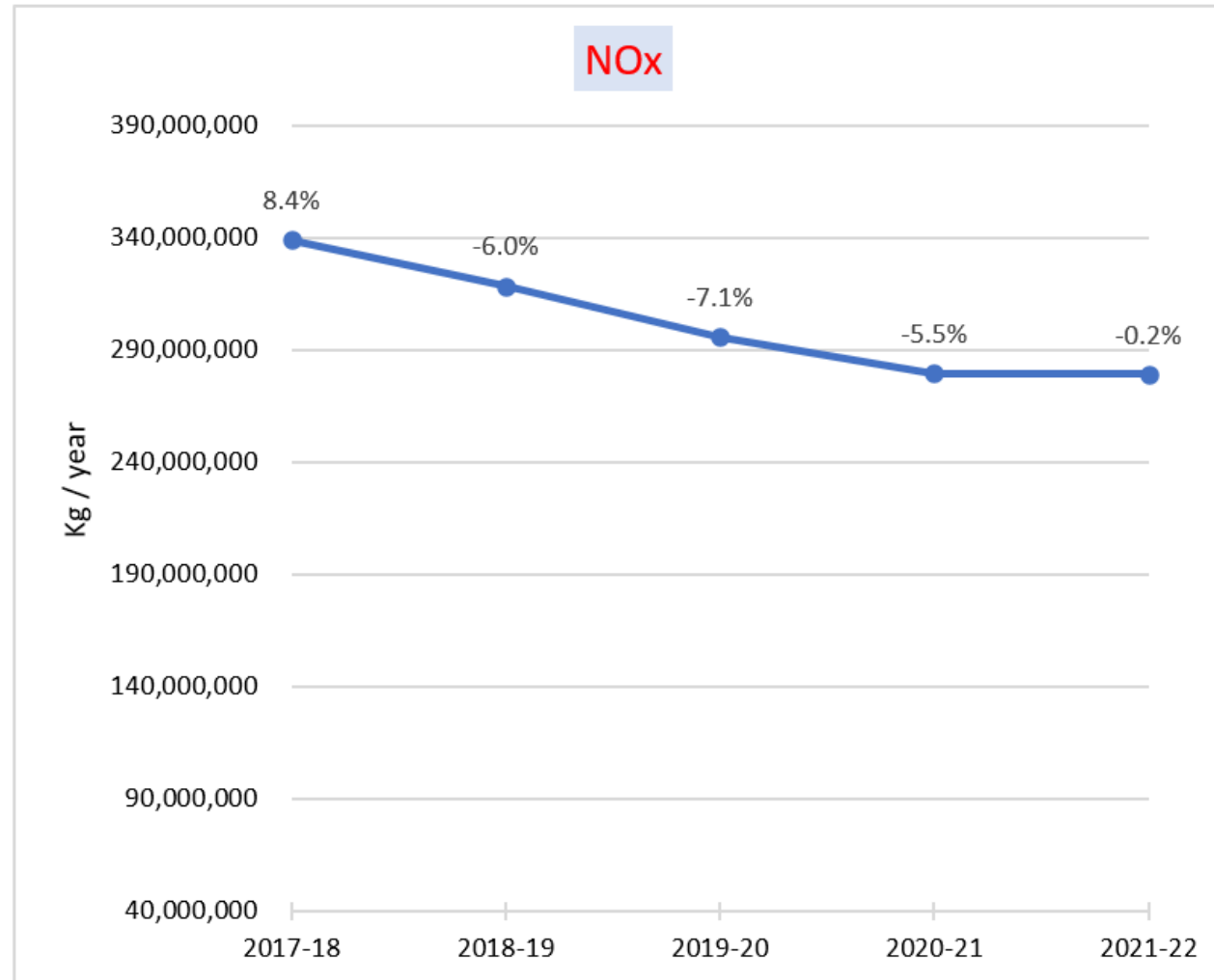

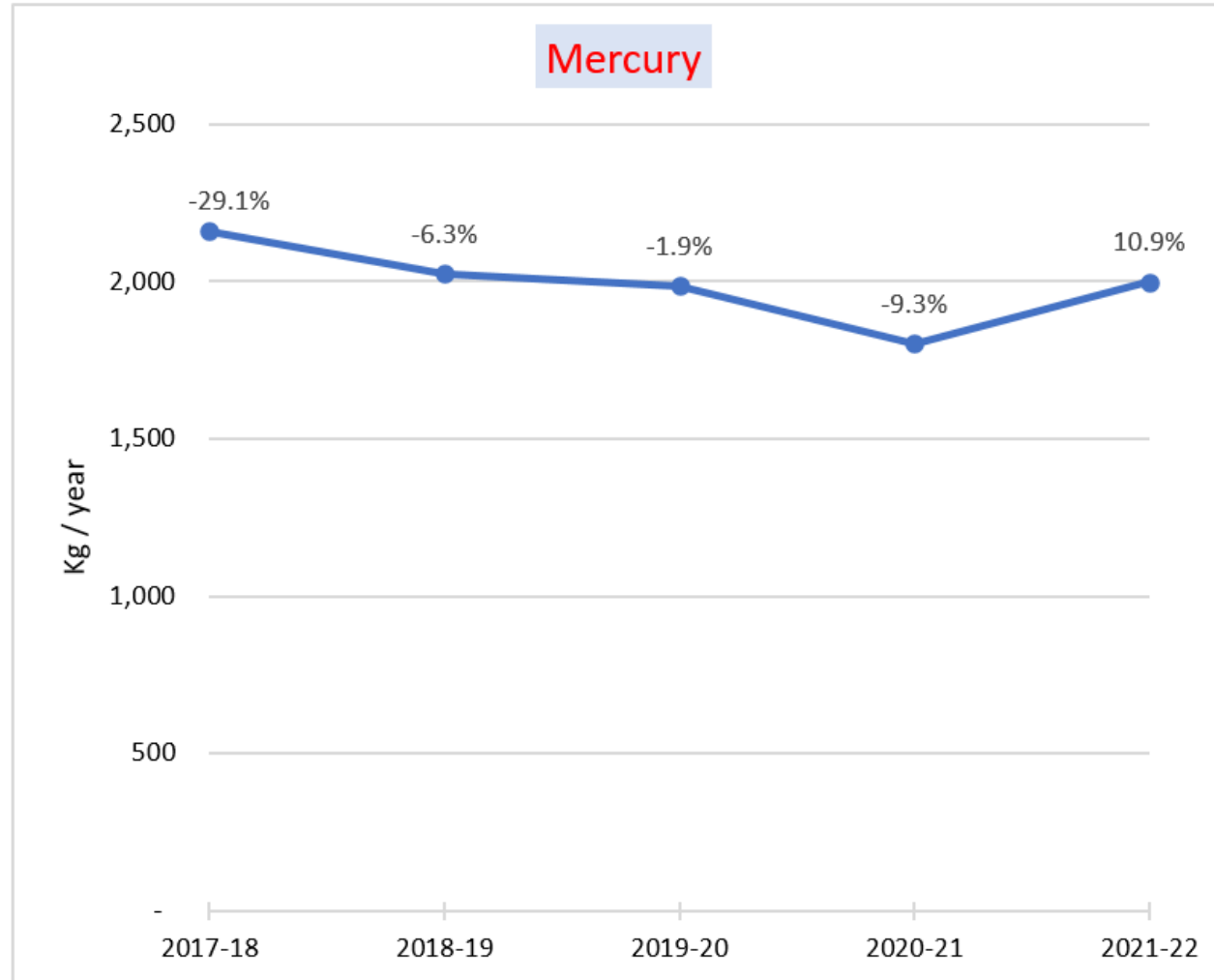
